Parashas VeZos HaBerachah - 5772 – Moshe's Berachah and Selichos

Moshe led the nation of Israel to Sinai to receive the Torah, transmitted the Ten Utterances *הגבורה* and, when he found that they had worshipped the Golden Calf, had smashed the Tablets of Stone upon which HaShem had summarized the Rules of Morality that He'd had in Mind for Israel and the World. HaShem had said then to Moshe, *"Let My anger flare against them, and I will destroy them, and I will make you into a great nation."* (Shemos 32:10) Moshe's instantaneous reaction had been, *"Moshe beseeched the Face of HaShem his G-d, and he said, 'Why, O HaShem, should You let Your anger flare against Your People, whom You took out from Egypt with great power and a mighty Hand? Why should Egypt say, 'With evil intent did He take them, to kill them in the desert mountains, and to destroy them from the face of the earth?' – Repent from the flare of Your anger, and turn back from Your evil intention regarding Your People!'"* (Shemos 32:11-12) HaShem's response was *"HaShem turned back from the evil intention which He had in Mind to do to His People."* (Shemos 32:14)

The other calamitous sin which the People of Israel committed in the Wilderness had to do with the "Meraglim," the spies, whom Moshe sent to scout out "Eretz Yisrael" on the eve of their entry into the Holy Land. Ten of the twelve, with the exception of Yehoshua and Kalev, came back with an evil report about the Land, which led to the following disaster: *"The entire assembly rose up and issued its voice, and the People wept that night... And they said to one another, 'Let us appoint a leader and let us return to Egypt!'"* (BaMidbar 14:1,4) *"HaShem said to Moshe, 'How long will this People provoke Me, and how long will they not have faith in Me, despite all the signs that I performed in their midst? I will smite them with the plague and annihilate them, and I shall make you a greater and more powerful nation than they.'" (BaMidbar 14:11-12)* But Moshe prayed for their forgiveness and *"HaShem said, 'I have forgiven because of your words.'" (BaMidbar 14:20)*

Moshe concludes the Song of VeZos HaBerachah, *"There is none like G-d, O Yeshurun; He rides across heaven to help you, and in His Majesty, through the upper heights. "מענה אלֵקֵי קִדְמָם" - "That is the abode of time immemorial, and below are the world's mighty ones. He drove the enemy away from before you, and He said, 'Destroy!' Thus Israel shall dwell secure, solitary, in the likeness of Yaakov, in a land of grain and wine; even his heavens shall drip with dew. Fortunate are you O Israel: Who is like you! O People delivered by HaShem, the Shield of your help, Who is the Sword of your grandeur..." (Devarim 33:26-28)*

As we approach Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement, which serves as the climax of the Ten Days of Repentance, we emulate our great leader, Moshe Rabbeinu, and offer "Selichos," Penitential Prayers," to our all-Merciful G-d:

1. A recitation of the Characteristics of HaShem, which HaShem revealed to Moshe to be used in times of trouble:

"HaShem, HaShem, Almighty, Compassionate and Gracious, Slow to Anger, Abundant in Kindness and Truth, Preserver of Kindness for thousands of generations, Forgiver of Iniquity, Willful Sin and Error, and Who Cleanses..."

2. We plead that HaShem respond to our prayers with His Attribute of Mercy

"Hear our voice, HaShem, our G-d, pity and be compassionate with us, and accept – with compassion and favor – our prayer. Bring us back to You, HaShem, and we shall return, renew our days as of old. Do not cast us away from Yourself, and do not remove Your Holy Spirit from us. Do not cast us away in old age; when our strength gives out, do not forsake us..."

3. The following stanza appears in the "Selichos" and re-appears in the "Neilah" Prayer, as the Gates of Heaven begin to close:

"Israel is saved by HaShem with an eternal salvation; Today, too, may they be saved by Your Word.

O Dweller in the Heights – for You are abundantly forgiving, and the Master of Mercies."
