## Parashas Nitzavim And Selichos for the Yomim Noraim

Parashas Nitzavim begins with a warning by Moshe Rabbeinu to the People of Israel, that they will be judged on the basis of whether they are perceived by Heaven as having been faithful to the Covenant of Chorev – whether they have observed the Commands of the Torah or not. It is strikingly parallel to the “Days of Awe,” in which the People of Israel are judged similarly.

”אשר יחדיו נמתיק סוד בבית אלהים נהלך ברגש” For together let us share sweet counsel; in the House of G-d let us walk in exaltation.” (Tehilim 55:15) This week we have recited the Selichos, prayers expressing our yearning to be forgiven on the Day of Judgment. The material is so massive, that I have restricted my discussion to the “פזמונים” the penitential hymns, combinations of prayer and song on the theme of “תשובה” “Repentance.” Each “פזמון” contains a refrain, which is shown in bold type.

The First Night of Selichos, Motzaei Shabbos, we arise to begin the struggle for forgiveness. The “פזמון” (Selichah 4) begins:

As the Day of Rest departs, we come before You, First of All; Bend Your ear from on high –

O You Who sits to hear Israel praise You,

O May You listen to our song and prayer.

On the Second Day, the “פזמון” (Selichah 7) begins with a stanza echoed in : **“נעילה”**  
Israel is saved by HaShem with an Eternal Salvation,

Today, too, may they be saved by Your Word, O Dweller in the Heights -

For You are abundantly Forgiving, and the Master of Mercies.

On the Third Day, the “פזמון” (Selichah 10) begins:

O Angels of Mercy, servants of the Supreme,

Entreat before G-d with eloquent expression,

Perhaps He will pity His poor and destitute people; perhaps He will have mercy.

On the Fourth Day, we address the “פזמון” (Selichah 13) to the One Who knows the innermost thoughts of Man:

Prober and Searcher of all, Who knows the intent of all my deeds,

Examine not my iniquity, inquire not after my wrongdoing;

HaShem, at dawn hear my voice!

On the Fifth Day, we appeal to HaShem with a “פזמון” (Selichah 16), the first stanza of which is echoed in **“נעילה”**:

Let us hear from Him Who sits in celestial concealment, ‘I have forgiven!’

By His Right Hand ‘s Salvation, may the poor and destitute people be saved.

HaShem, be our Helper

On the Sixth Day, we recite a “פזמון” (Selichah 19), which is very reminiscent of the speech of Queen Esther in the Megilla:

O You Who sits in the hidden heights, my shield and my protector,

Attend to my outcry, and hearken to my prayer’s song.

Spare my life at my request, and my people at my petition.

On Day Seven, we appeal to G-d with a “פזמון” (Selichah 22) to show towards us the mercy of parents:

Even if our iniquities bear witness against us, we come before You, contrite and trusting.

As a father is merciful to his children, so have mercy on us; Comfort us as a man is comforted by his mother.

Punish us not in Your anger, lest You destroy us completely.

On Erev Rosh HaShanah, the recitation of Selichos is much longer than on the earlier days. In one of the three “פזמונים” (Selichah 40), we ask HaShem to “tip the scales” of Justice in our behalf:

You Who tip the scales towards kindness, tipping Man towards renewed life, tip Your People’s scales towards kindness;

Grant them that they may live; Inscribe the sign of life, let it be on their forehead continually,

As the morning Olah, that is part of the Permanent Olah Sacrifice.

In the spirit of the “פזמונים” above, the conclusion of the Selichos gently reminds HaShem, “Will You not arise and show Zion Mercy, for it is time to be gracious to her.” (Tehillim 107:14)
