## Parashas Mishpatim "Wasps and Big Brothers

When I was a little boy, my family used to go for nine days (not "The Nine Days") at the end of each summer for a brief vacation. The first vacations I remember were at the Monsey Park Hotel, across the road from a dairy farm (now the Monsey Park senior citizen residence, across the road from the Regency garden apartment complex). The days I remember most were spent mainly in the swimming pool and in the dining room. I used to love to swim, but I remember one occasion when my father, A"H, my older brother and I were in the pool, joined by a wasp. The wasp was having fun flying to each of our heads in turn, threatening to sting us. Each of us would go underwater, until the danger was past, and the wasp would have gone to a different potential victim. Finally, the wasp landed on my father's head and discharged its venom.

What brings that little vignette to mind was the final one of the "nimukim," the "thoughts" presented by Rabbi Shimon Schwab, ZT"L, former Rav of K'hil Adas Yeshurun of Washington Heights, on Parashas Mishpatim. *"I shall send my fear before you, and I will confound the entire people among whom you shall come; and I shall make all your enemies turn the backs of their necks. I shall send the hornet swarm before you and it will drive away the Hivvite, the Canaanite, and the Hittite before you. I shall not drive them away from you in a single year, lest the Land become desolate and the wildlife of the field multiply against you. Little by little shall I drive them away from you, until you become fruitful and make the Land your Heritage."* (Shemos 23:27-30)

And as Chaza"l say in Maseches Sotah (36a, and it is also brought by Rashi on Parashas Eikev 7:20), that the hornet used to fill their enemies with fear, and then there would not have rested upon Israel the obligation of "You shall not leave one of them alive," but rather the Holy One, Blessed be He, would have done everything, and no shield nor spear would have been seen among all the hosts of Israel. But because they ruined their behavior, they were forced into war and they had to annihilate the seven nations. And all this was because of the sin of the Meraglim."

My brother, Sam, whose English birthday, January 25, happens to be this Shabbos, traveled the YU path as he grew up. Since we grew up in Washington Heights, he had many friends in the Breuer Community, as he attended Pirchei meetings and Agudah trips and outings (with me tagging along). He always bemoaned the fact that relations weren't closer between the two communities, and although he realized that there were serious issues dividing them, he felt that the need for Jewish Unity overrode them.

Laid back and genial, but always loyal to his kids, he was able to transmit his values to them. Some made Aliyah, others work here in Jewish-related fields, like Kiruv, and Chinuch, and others in other health-related professions, but all remain 100% loyal to Torah and Mitzvos. And he was always a loyal big brother to me and my family. Let me cite one example of the previous statement. Once, our families got together and went on an outing to Bear Mt. State Park, and we decided to climb the mountain. Of course we didn't take the well-marked trails up the mountain, but chose instead a relatively difficult unmarked trail. Naturally, I found myself hanging by my fingernails to an outcropping of rock, much to the amusement of most of our family members. Except for my brother, who immediately came to my aid.
