Parashas Ki-Setze –

Music, Delight and Torah, “Choson” and “Kallah”

“In Chodesh Elul, we begin the daily recitation of *“LeDavid; HaShem Ori VeYishi”* – *“A Psalm of David; HaShem is my Light and my Salvation.”* In the psalm, we find *“Ashirah VaAzamera LaHaShem”* – *I will sing and make music to HaShem.*” There is a close connection between the study of Torah and music. David was one of the greatest Torah scholars of Israel. But he was also a great religious poet and musician, known as the **“ne’im zemiros Yisrael,” “the greatest religious musician of Israel.”**

This past week, Miriam and I participated in a beautiful family Simchah, the “Shevah Berachos,” the “Seven Blessings” of the granddaughter of my cousins, Rabbi Pinchas and Hennie Kahn, the daughter of their son and daughter-in-law, Rabbi Avraham and Mrs. Tammy Kahn, Tsiri and her “choson,” Elchonon. Pinchas and Hennie have eight sons and one daughter, all married. Each of the sons is a “Talmid Chochom” in his own right, as is their son-in-law. **But each combines his Torah learning with an intense “VeHa’arev Na,”** a request to HaShem to help him make his Torah learning a delight. Each has a beautiful voice and sang and danced with their children and the rest of the family and guests to be “mesame’ach,” to increase the joy of the the ‘Choson’ and ‘Kallah.’

Rav Pinchas and several of his sons spoke, each weaving together a tapestry of song, Torah and love, from the perspective of Chaza”l, emphasizing the crucial roles of “Choson” and “Kallah” in building a “bayis ne’eman b’Yisrael.”

Two of the Seven Blessings have the following compositions:

“Gladden the beloved companions as You gladdened Your creatures in the Garden of Eden long ago. Blessed are You, HaShem, **Who gladdens ‘Choson’ and ‘Kallah.’**”

“Blessed are You, HaShem, our God, King of the universe, Who created joy and gladness, **‘Choson’ and ‘Kallah,’ glad song,** pleasure, delight, love, brotherhood, peace and companionship. HaShem, our God, let there soon be heard in the cities of Yehudah and the streets of Yerushalayim the sound of joy and the sound of gladness, the voice of the ‘Choson’ and the voice of the ‘Kallah,’ the sound of the ‘Chosons’ ’ jubilation from their canopies and of youths from their song-filled feasts. **Blessed are You, Who gladdens the ‘Choson’ together with the ‘Kallah.’**”
