Parashas Naso Shavuos

“Kabbolas HaTorah,” “Siyum HaShas,” “Neilas HaChag” and
“Hachnosas Sefer Torah”

The word “Naso” means “to elevate.” Parashios Naso and BaMidbar surround the receipt of the Written Torah at Mt. Sinai by the People of Israel, which began their elevation to a high spiritual level, as described in the Torah reading on the Holiday of Shavuos.

Coincidentally, Rabbi Gottlieb's Daf Yomi began its study of the Oral Torah with Maseches Nedarim, some seven years ago. At that time, Maseches Kesuvos was completed, as it was this year. Our rabbi decided that the second day of Shavuos was a very appropriate time to celebrate the Siyum of Maseches Kesuvos, the Siyum HaShas, combined with a Neilas HaChag. The rabbi performed the Siyumim and Moe Tilson described the history of the rabbi's Daf Yomi.

Some seven and a half years ago, Steve Fessel, Moe Tilson, and Mendy Rosenbaum combined forces to convince the rabbi to initiate a Daf Yomi in our shul. Moe described the growth over time of the Learning Group under the brilliant guidance of Rabbi Gottlieb, as each new member joined the group and contributed his own unique talents to the learning. He described the fruitful “Shakla V'Tarya” with the rabbi and among the members of the “Chabura.” For some of the members of the group, it was not their first pass thru “Shas,” and this was reflected in their comments and questions.

Moe paid tribute to the incredibly talented “Maggid Shiur,” a photographic memory, an “Oker Harim” in intellect and a vast knowledge and instant familiarity with the entire corpus of the “Torah she B'al Peh,” “Rishonim,” “Acharonim,” and modern-day Gedolim. Combined with a cheerful and respectful attitude towards the “Talmidim,” it was a recipe for great progress in learning.

Rabbi Gottlieb paid tribute to Rav Meir Shapiro, the founder of the concept of the “Daf Yomi,” and also the Art Scroll Publishing House, who played a great role in implementing it. He expressed his gratitude to the students of his “Daf,” citing the comment of one of the Talmudic masters that his knowledge was increased by his teachers, by his colleagues and, most of all, by his fruitful interactions with his students. He also gave thanks to the wives of the students, who played a great role in the progress of the students in learning.

Finally, to come full circle, from Written to Oral and back to the Written Torah, Pinchas, Miriam and Grandpa Joe will present our shul this Sunday with a Sefer Torah written in Bnei Brak by an expert Sofer, in memory of their son and grandson, R' Aharon Baruch Mordechai, Z”L, who also excelled in Safrus and many other fields of knowledge.
