Parashas Vayechi— “Simchas Nisuin,” “Wedding Bliss”

This week's parashah speaks of the last years of Yaakov on earth. But let us first look at a brief biography of Yaakov. A crucial moment in Yaakov's life was the time that he received a blessing and matrimonial advice from his father, Yitzchok, upon his departure for the house of Lavan: “Arise, go to Padan-Aram... and take a wife from there from the daughters of Lavan, your mother's brother.” (Bereshis 28:2)

Yaakov proceeds to the house of Lavan, and builds there the first “Bayis Neeman Be-Yisroel.” Events continue to unfold, and Yoseph, using his God-given power of dream-interpretation, manages to find his way to near-supreme power in Egypt. He is able to re-unify his family, bringing down his father and his brothers to Egypt. After seventeen years in Goshen, Yaakov senses that his life is coming to an end, and he gathers his sons around him to receive their final blessings.

This week, our shul will celebrate a great “simchah;” viz. the wedding of the eldest son of our “Morah D'Asra,” Rav Yisroel Gottlieb, and his wife, Amy - Yoseph, to the eldest daughter of Nachum and Miriam Rosenberg - K.C. “Invay HaGefen be-Invay HaGefen!”

I am going to use Rabbi Natan Slifkin's book, “Nature's Song” on “Perek Shirah,” from his chapter on the dove, a bird representing “Fidelity and Loyalty” in discussing this “Shidduch.”

“Fidelity with Partners”

“The dove is a monogamous bird, demonstrating the quality of fidelity and loyalty. After the eggs are laid, both parents take on the task of incubation, with a fairly regular division of labor; the male sits on the eggs for much of the day, and the female sits on them for the rest of the time. When the chicks hatch, both parents share the job of feeding them...Most significant of all, after the brood has been reared, the doves do not abandon each other in favor of others, but stay together to produce further broods over the course of the year.”

“Fidelity with God”

“The fidelity of the dove is meant to teach us more than fidelity with our marital partners on earth. It also represents the loyalty that we display to our partner in Heaven. This is no mere coincidence, as the purpose of earthly relationships is to enable us to better understand and fulfill our relationship with God. The “Megilah” of Song of Songs, whose story of love alludes to our relationship with God, uses the dove to teach us this lesson.”

“Behold, you are beautiful, My love; behold, you are beautiful; your eyes are doves.” (Song of Songs 1:15)
