Parashas Behar – “Matters of Interest” to Interest

Towards the end of Parashas Behar, the Torah discusses ways to avoid the problem of a fellow Jew who has begun to fall into the clutches of poverty. Rabbi Shimon Schwab, ZT”L, former Rav of “Kehal Adas Yeshurun,” comments on some of those verses in his “sefer,” “Ma’ayan Beis HaShoevah.”

*“If your brother becomes impoverished and his means begin to falter... **Do not take from him interest and increase, and you shall fear your God – and let your brother live with you.**” (VaYikra 25:35-36)*

Although stealing from a non-Jew is forbidden, it is permitted to charge interest, because this is normal business practice. It is, however, not permitted to charge interest to a Jew, even in business.

“It is totally forbidden in the realm of one’s family, and one may never take ‘interest’ from one’s ‘brother.’ And those who would lend money for ‘interest’ to his family, contradict the very idea of the ‘brotherhood’ of the People of Israel, for it is not appropriate to demand ‘interest’ in that context. And therefore, the Torah emphasizes here the word ‘brother’ in the verse *‘If your brother becomes impoverished’... and let your brother live with you.*”

“Do not lend your money for interest, and do not give your food for increase. I am HaShem your God, Who took you out of the land of Egypt...” (VaYikra 25: 37-38)

“And the understanding of the one who lends with ‘Ribis’ to a Jew, and falsely claims that he’d lent to a non-Jew, and one who attaches a thread to his garment and falsely claims that it is ‘techeiles,’ and one who applies salt to his scales are nothing other than examples of the falsehood that abounds in the World of Falsehood. For the benefit of the Exodus from Egypt and the fulfillment of the Promise to the Avos was the cancellation of falsehood and the Revelation of Absolute Truth at the time of the Killing of the First-Born, to the extent of the distinguishing between the drop of semen which became a first-born and the drop of semen which did not become a first-born, as is written in the Sacred Writings (Vaera 6:3) *‘And My Holy Name I did not reveal to them,’* and Rashi explains the meaning ‘I did not reveal myself with the Attribute of Truthfulness, for Which I am called HaShem.’”

“The Torah concludes Parashas Tzitzis with the word ‘Emes’ according to the Mesorah (Yirmiyahu 10:10) *‘And HaShem Elokim is Truth,’* because the essence of the Exodus from Egypt was in the revelation of the Absolute Truth of ‘I am the One and not Another,” and therefore we say, *‘I am HaShem your God Who took you out of the land of Egypt... I am HaShem your God’ – Truth.*”
