## Parashas Baha'alosecha –

### The Only Korbon Pesach brought in the Midbar

The Ramban discusses the above fact, that the Korbon Pesach mentioned in our parashah, was the only one brought by the Jewish People in the wilderness, from three different perspectives:

The blazing heat of the desert makes it quite dangerous to perform the rite of circumcision. If someone in one's family is not circumcised, that person is considered a non-Jew, which, according to most opinions, is a disqualification for that individual and for his family to offer the Korbon Pesach. The north wind is the relief to this heat, but it did not blow for the forty years that the Jewish People were in the desert. Thus, it was not the fault of the Jews that they did not offer the Pesach sacrifice.

According to the Sifre, it was indeed their fault, because it was an expression of the anger of HaShem over their rejection of Eretz Yisrael, because they believed in the testimony of the majority of the "Meraglim" that they could not conquer Eretz Yisrael, because of the fierceness of its residents, and they rejected the testimony of Calev and Yehoshua, the good "Meraglim," Moshe and Aharon, and most of all, HaShem, that they could indeed conquer the Land, that the north wind did not blow.

A third possibility is that the lack of circumcision does not prevent one from eating the Korbon Pesach, but the Jewish People were just too lazy to do it. But the Ramban rejects this possibility out of hand, because of his certainty that Moshe would have forced them to offer the Sacrifice, because not to do so would have subjected them to the penalty of "Kares."

### The Ohr HaChayim

The Jewish People, in view of the fact that they had constructed the Golden Calf, had placed themselves in the category of "benei neichor," "worshippers of foreign gods," rendering themselves forbidden to eat the Korbon Pesach. Therefore, it was necessary for HaShem to give them special permission to do so at this time, but only at this time. And that is the meaning of "And the Children of Israel was able to offer the Korbon Pesach in its proper time." (BaMidbar 9:2)

"Scripture identified four meritorious acts performed by the People of Israel, in virtue of which they merited to enter the Land of Israel without any war, were it not for the "Meraglim," as Moshe testified to Yisro (BaMidbar 10:29), "We will be traveling to the place..."

In addition to what they did on the Eighth Day of Consecration and the Inauguration of the Princes, they will be able also to perform the procedures regarding the Korbon Pesach; that they won't be relieved of it by virtue of the Joy of the Commands that they had already done, as was the case regarding the First Temple, regarding which our Teachers taught that King Solomon somehow cancelled Yom Kippur because of the joy of the Inauguration of the Temple."
