Parashas Shemos— Farewell to a Very Good Man

We were in Highland Park this past Shabbos, in order to celebrate the Siddur Party of my grandson Sunday morning, preparatory to our departure for Eretz Yisrael on Monday, for the wedding of my brother's granddaughter, two very happy occasions, when we received some very sad news from Monsey. Our good friend, Alan Nussbaum, had lost his battle with cancer.

We both grew up in Washington Heights, his family among the stalwarts of the German community, associated with the great Rav, Rabbi Breuer, succeeded by Rabbi Schwab, and later by Rabbi Gelly. I was part of the YU community. He married a lovely young woman, Miriam Hammelburger, also from the Heights, also from the Breuer community. Alan served in the United States Army, stationed in Germany. He and Miriam had wonderful children, all Shomrei Shabbat, and knowledgeable in Torah. Alan was very well respected in our community, mainly for his modesty and other fine Midos. More recently, he served as the President of our Kehilah, and Rabbi Gottlieb, who performed the "levaya" for Alan, said that in general, when he would be approached by a shul president, he would be anxious, not knowing what the problem was, but with Alan, his approach always preceded a pleasant conversation.

The "levaya," before a packed house, was preceded by readings from Sefer Tehilim by two of Alan's mechutanin, Rabbi Marc Angel, former rabbi of the Spanish-Portuguese Synagogue in Manhattan and Dr. Adler, father of Rabbi Ari Adler, Keri's husband. Several of the grand children spoke, all recalling loving memories of their grandfather. His three sons also spoke eloquently about their father, and his loving marriage with his wife.

Alan and Miriam were part-owners of Camp Regesh, a community jewel, which succeeded Eagle Day Camp. In fact, Alan and Miriam were very similar to the owners of Eagle Day Camp, Rabbi Alfred Respler and his wife Rolie, two very fine individuals, followed by another pair of very fine individuals.

We enjoyed a mini-vacation to Cooperstown, lying on the shores of one of the Finger Lakes, and home of the Baseball Hall of Fame, with the Nussbaum's.. We enjoyed boating on the Lake, and swimming off the boat. It was a very pleasant trip with a very pleasant family.
