Parashas Matos Masei— A Bittersweet Departure and A New Beginning

The historical context of the two parashios which we read this Shabbos is the cusp of the entry of the Nation of Israel into Eretz Yisrael for the first time. Parashas Matos describes the victory of the Jewish People over the forces of Sichon and Og and Parashas Masei describes the travels of the Jewish People in the Wilderness for the past 40 years, from Mitzrayim to Arvos Moav.

Their Simchas Beis HaShoeva was always a highlight of Succos. With creativity and idealism, they dispensed warmth and friendship and "chessed" in our community, had wonderful relationships with all our rabbis, and made a huge number of friends.

They are now themselves making "Aliyah," joining all their children in the Holy Land, who have put down roots in the soil of Israel, and are raising families in the spirit of Jewish values and in the light of "Aschalta DiGeulah" (Beginning of the Redemption). אצאתכם לשלום and much הצלחה.
