Parashas Vaeschanan – “Shabbos Nachamu”

Last Shabbos, Shabbos Chazon, I wrote that no forecast of punishment of the Jewish People was permanent. That principle was verified this week by contrasting verses from Megilas Eichah, with citations from the book, “Jerusalem, Then, Now and Forever,” by Sharon Gabay, which showed that negative pronouncements in the Megilah had been converted, in our time, “ , from thick darkness to a great light.”

1. “Her gates have sunk into the earth, He has utterly shattered her bars; her king and officers are among the heathen, **there is no Torah; her prophets, too, find no vision from HaShem.**” (Eichah 2:9)

Rabbi Ovadiah Yosef (1920-2012), formerly Chief Rabbi of Israel: “The State of Israel today is the Torah center of the entire world. Of the hundreds of thousands of Jewish citizens, may they multiply and spread, some 22,000 precious young men [and women] – from the best of our sons [and daughters] – are involved in Torah night and day in the holy yeshivas, all over the country...and that does not include the hundreds of thousands of faithful educating their children at a high level in Torah-religious education...

‘Behold, days are coming – the word of G-d – when I will send a hunger into the land. Not a hunger for bread or a thirst for water, but to hear the word of G-d.’ ” (Amos 8:11)

2. “She weeps bitterly in the night and her tear is on her cheek. **She has no comforters from among all those who love her; all her friends have betrayed her. They have become her enemies.**” (Eichah 1:2)

“For G-d will comfort Zion... joy and goodness will be found there, thanksgiving and the sound of music.” (Yeshayahu 51:3)

3. “Her adversaries have become her master, her enemies are at ease, for HaShem has agrieved her for her abundant transgressions...” (Eichah 1:5)

“Many nations will go and say: **come, let us go up to the Mountain of G-d...and He will teach us His ways.**” (Yeshayahu 2:3)

4. “My eyes fail with tears, my insides are disturbed...” (Eichah 2:11)

“...The joy of a day passed within your courts, O Jerusalem! Visiting the ruins of the Temple and crying over the ruined sanctuary; where it is granted to me to caress your stones, to fondle your dust, and to weep over your ruins. I wept bitterly, but I found joy in my tears. I tore my garments, but I felt solace in it.” (Ramban, 1267)

5. “Arise, cry out at night in the beginning of the watches! Pour out your heart like water in the Presence of the L-rd...” (Eichah 2:19)

“Awake, awake, wear your might, O Zion; Put on your beautiful garments, Jerusalem, the Holy City.” (Yeshayahu 52:1)

6. “The kings of the earth did not believe; nor did any of the world’s inhabitants, that the adversary or enemy could enter the gates of Jerusalem.” (Eichah 4:12)

“We have never given up on Jerusalem; we have never disconnected from her. Every single day we have mentioned her in our prayers, at our tables and on our festive occasions. Every observant Jew who prays and recites the Blessings after the meal three times a day – mentions Jerusalem 21 times every single day. And this has been going on for two thousand consecutive years...” (Rabbi Moshe Tzvi Neriya addressing the Zionist Congress, 1975)

7. “The roads of Zion are in mourning for lack of festival pilgrims. All her gates are desolate, her priests sigh; her maidens are aggrieved, and she herself is embittered.” (Eichah 1:4)

“G-d said, ‘I shall not enter Heavenly Jerusalem, until I enter earthly Jerusalem.’ ” (Talmud Ta’anis 5a)
